
### Kootenay Rockies Summary January, 2023

- Kootenay Rockies had an ADR of \$285 for the month of January, up 0.5% compared to the same month in 2022. BC had an ADR of \$219 for the month of January.
- Kootenay Rockies had a RevPAR of \$166 for the month of January, up 0.8% compared to the same month in 2022. BC had a RevPAR of \$115.6 for the month of January.



#### **ADR**





#### **British Columbia January Census total: 309,729 listings**


#### **Key Findings**

- Out of the regions, Vancouver Island had the highest number of total available nights from active listings in January 2023 with **147,309**, followed by Thompson Okanagan with **84,776**, Kootenay Rockies with **62,139**, and Northern BC with **12,405**.
- Cariboo Chilcotin Coast had the lowest number of total available nights from active listings in January 2023 with 3,100

#### **Key Findings**

- Out of the regions, Vancouver Island had the highest number of booked nights from active listings in January 2022 with **68,340,** followed by Thompson Okanagan with **50,040**, Kootenay Rockies with **36,199**, and Northern BC with **6,285**.
- Cariboo Chilcotin Coast had the lowest number of booked nights from active listings in January 2023 with 1,265

## Glossary

- Occupancy: Calculated by the number of occupied rooms divided by the number of available rooms that physically exist in a hotel
- Average Daily Rate (ADR): Represents the average rental income per paid occupied room in a given time period, however, ADR itself cannot be used to measure a hotel's performance
- Revenue per Available Room (RevPAR): Calculated by multiplying a hotel's ADR by its occupancy rate, an increase in RevPAR most likely indicates an improvement in occupancy rate and can be used to measure a hotel's performance
- Listings Supply (Nights): Total number of Available Nights + Booked Nights from Active Listings
- Listings Demand (Nights): Total number of Booked Nights during the reporting period
