- British Columbia had an ADR of **\$220.9** for the month of October up **11.9%** compared to the same month in 2022.

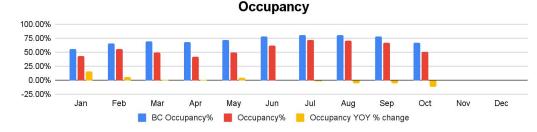

## Kootenay Rockies Summary October 2023

- Kootenay Rockies had a 50.8% occupancy for the month of October down 11.5% compared to the same month in 2022. BC had a 66.5% occupancy for the month of October.
- Kootenay Rockies had an ADR of \$153.1 for the month of October up 5.1% compared to the same month in 2022. BC had an ADR of \$220.9 for the month of October.
- Kootenay Rockies had a RevPAR of **\$77.8** for the month of October down **7.0%** compared to the same month in 2022. BC had a RevPAR of **\$146.9** for the month of October.

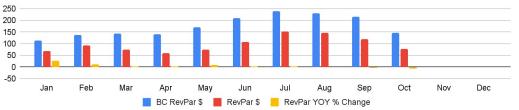




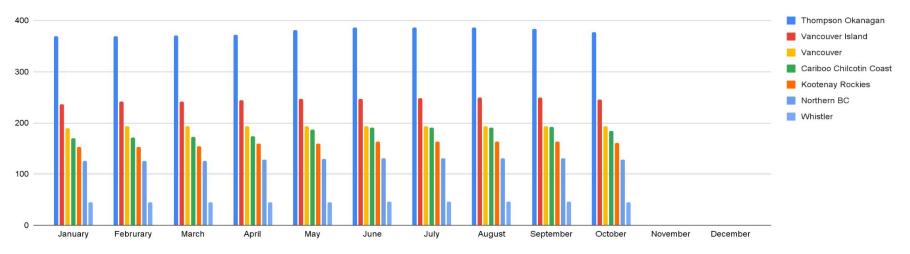

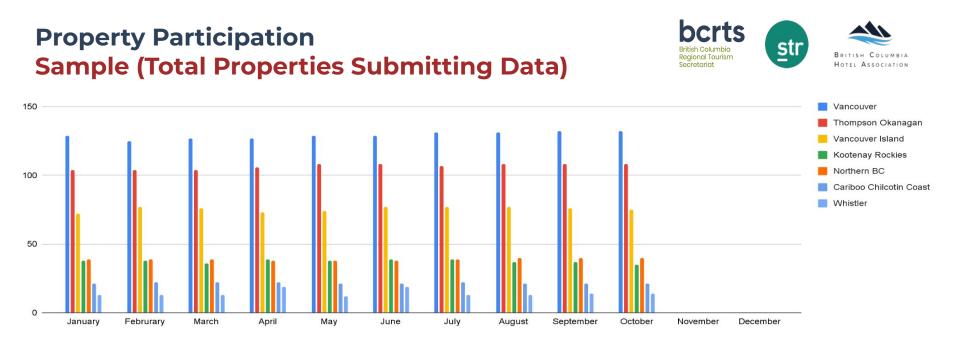

### Summary

- Out of the regions, Thompson Okanagan had the highest number of properties in the STR database (Census) in October 2023 with 377, followed by Vancouver Island with 246, Vancouver with 194, Cariboo Chilcotin Coast with 185, Kootenay Rockies with 161, and Northern BC with 128.
- Whistler had the lowest number of properties in the database in October 2023 with **45.**

## **Key Findings**

- Vancouver had the highest property participation with 132 out of the 194 properties reporting data in October 2023, followed by Thompson Okanagan with 108 out of 377, Vancouver Island with 75 out of 246, Kootenay Rockies with 35 out of 161, Northern BC with 40 out of 128, and Cariboo Chilcotin Coast with 21 out of 185.
- Whistler had the lowest property participation with 14 out of the 45 properties reporting data in October 2023.

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# Glossary

- Occupancy: Calculated by the number of occupied rooms divided by the number of available rooms that physically exist in a STR.
- Average Daily Rate (ADR): Represents the average rental income per paid occupied room in a given time period; however, ADR itself cannot be used to measure a STR's performance.
- Revenue per Available Room (RevPAR): Calculated by multiplying a STR's ADR by its occupancy rate, an increase in RevPAR most likely indicates an improvement in occupancy rate and can be used to measure a STR's performance.
